The WMM outlines, so beautifully, the colors used in our crest. The theme we have chosen for this year also meshes with the scriptures at the very core of PWOC.

- The Turquoise cross represents our PWOC color denoting the presence of God, which brings freedom, refreshment and the life-giving energy of the Holy Spirit.
- The word Transforming uses the cross as the T and the gradation of the remaining letters shows our transformation by the Holy Spirit, whose presence transforms us and enables us to make a difference in the culture in which we live. As we abide in His presence, we are empowered to share the Good News of Jesus Christ to others in need.
- The multiple hearts allow a rest from words while still making clear the word is Hearts. They are Red signifying the life-giving blood that is physical and spiritual.
- The Gold letters of the word God's, stands for His love which is more precious than gold. In Psalm 36:7-9 are these words: "How precious is thy steadfast love, O God!"
- The T in the word Truth uses the cross again. The Dark Blue letters stands for freedom, which we know as Christians. Jesus died and we are free from sin. Jesus says: "...you will know the truth and the truth will set you free." John 8:32
