


[Parenting: 14 Gospel Principles That Can Radically Change Your Family](#)

[Marriage Matters: Extraordinary Change through Ordinary Moments](#) by Winston Smith



...thought of the Bible as nothing more than a set of rules to be followed?



[The Envy of Eve: Finding Contentment in a Covetous World](#) by Melissa Kruger


What's truly at the heart of our desires?


[By Design: God's Distinctive Call To Women](#) By Susan Hunt.


[Women of the Word: How to Study the Bible with Both Our Hearts and Our Minds](#) by Jenn Wilkin


It can be run before or after **Christianity Explored** or Alpha and is perfect for anyone looking for answers to life's big questions.



[Enjoying God: Finding Hope in the Attributes of God](#) by R.C. Sproul






[A Loving Life: In a World of Broken Relationships](#) by Paul E. Miller

How do you love with no love in return?


How do you love when no one notices or cares?
