ISAIAH 26:3-4

Theme Explanation:

"You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you, because he trusts in you. Trust in the Lord forever, for the Lord God is an everlasting rock." - Isaiah 26:3-4

Don't we often feel like we are walking around in the Wilderness?

We struggle and try to get out of it, to overcome it, to seek out any means to escape it. We put our hopes in other people and other things.

But, here, in Isaiah 26, we're reminded that what God will have for us is good. We have a strong city where His righteous faithful people live. We have peace because we are fixed on him. He is our rock!

The **bear shape** represents that wilderness we seem to feel and experience often. **The clouds**, that hide some of the sun's glory are beginning to move out as we trust the Lord more and more. **The lady** is praising the Lord because she has ***"found His rest while wandering in the wilderness"***. The **mountain** she stands on is rocky, but Isaiah 26 reminds us the Lord makes our paths level and straight. The **birds** fly together peacefully. They know who their maker is!
